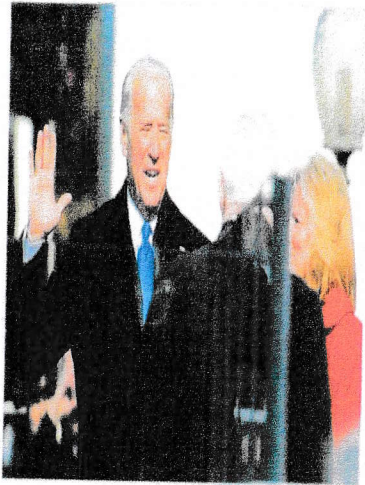

Oaths of office



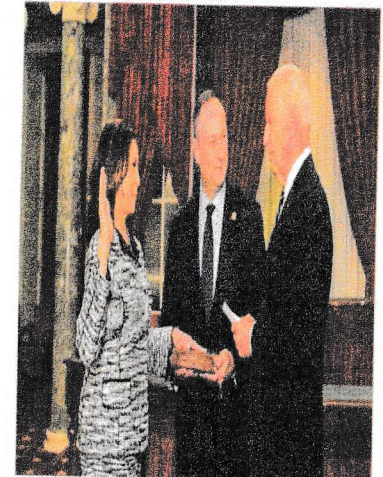
Biden was sworn into the vice-presidency by Associate Justice John Paul Stevens on January 20, 2009.

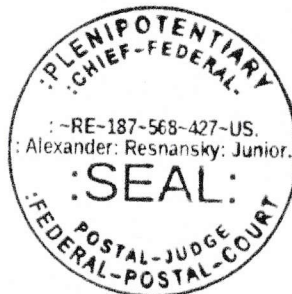

Harris was sworn into the Senate by then-outgoing Vice President Biden on January 3, 2017.



Upon assuming office, Biden will receive a traditional 21-gun salute in his honor and proceed to deliver his inaugural address.

Inaugural address

Biden's speech will "[lay] out his vision to beat [COVID-19], build back better, and bring the country together," according to his inaugural committee. [52] He will ask Americans to wear facial coverings to prevent the spread of COVID-19 for the first 100 days of his presidency.
